

Tibial Plateau-Leveling Osteotomy (TPLO) Frequently Asked Questions

Is there an online lecture for this course?

Yes. There are five pre-lab lectures, each worth one Continuing Education credit. You'll receive an email with access to the Securos VetBloom dashboard 30 days before the hands-on workshop. Please note that these courses need to be completed prior to the lab.

Is this course RACE approved?

Yes. This course has been approved by the American Association of Veterinary State Boards (AAVSB) RACE program and meets the requirements for 13.5 continuing education credits for Veterinarians and Veterinary Technicians. 5.0 credits for the pre-lab lectures and 8.5 credits for the hands-on workshop.

What should I wear?

Attendees should wear attire that is comfortable and cadaver friendly. Securos University will provide plastic aprons, gloves, and masks to protect you and your clothes, but accidents happen. Scrubs are always a good choice.

Will I receive handouts?

Yes. This course includes reference guides. Additional hand-outs are provided upon request.

Will we be working with cadavers or bone models?

Both. Each attendee first practices the TPLO on a bone model that they'll keep. Attendees then practice measurements on two knees-leading on one surgery and assist on a second surgery. These knees are then radiographed and evaluated by instructors in preparation for a third and fourth round. The course concludes with a final round of radiographs with evaluations and a closing wine and cheese reception.
